



Exhibition Proposals Terrace Art Gallery

The Terrace Art Gallery (Terrace Art Association) welcomes exhibition proposals from artists and curators. The Gallery produces 12 to 15 exhibitions each year from January to November, including the annual Youth Art Show in May and the annual Members Show in summer. Exhibitions generally run for three weeks, opening on the first Friday evening and closing on the last Saturday of the calendar month. The Gallery's exhibition schedule is generally booked one to two years in advance. The Curatorial Committee meets in June and December each year to select and schedule the following year's exhibitions. Completed exhibition proposals may be submitted at any time but will be held up to six months for Curatorial Committee review. There is no exhibition fee but all exhibiting artists must be current members of the Terrace Art Association. We do not accept e-mailed or faxed exhibition proposals at this time.

Exhibition Proposals must include:

- ❑ **Up-to-date resume or curriculum vitae for each exhibiting artist** – provide contact information, education, exhibition history, teaching or work experience related to your art and relevant published reviews or articles
- ❑ **Exhibition statement** – a detailed description of the proposed work, including any working titles, types of media, and technical requirements
- ❑ **Images (slides or CD)** – 10-20 images of the work that you are proposing to exhibit, labeled with the artist's name and image number. **Do not send original works of art.**
- ❑ **Image list** – documentation for all numbered images including artist's name, title of work, date of production, medium and dimensions
- ❑ **Exhibition schedule** – indicate your first and second choice of exhibition date or if you have no preferred date
- ❑ **Gallery requirements** – detail your spatial and other requirements, including Upper and/or Lower Gallery, wall and floor space, plinths or tables, electrical outlets
- ❑ **Submission return envelope** – a self-addressed, sufficiently stamped envelope if you wish your materials to be returned

Packages that do not include all of the above information are incomplete and will not be considered.

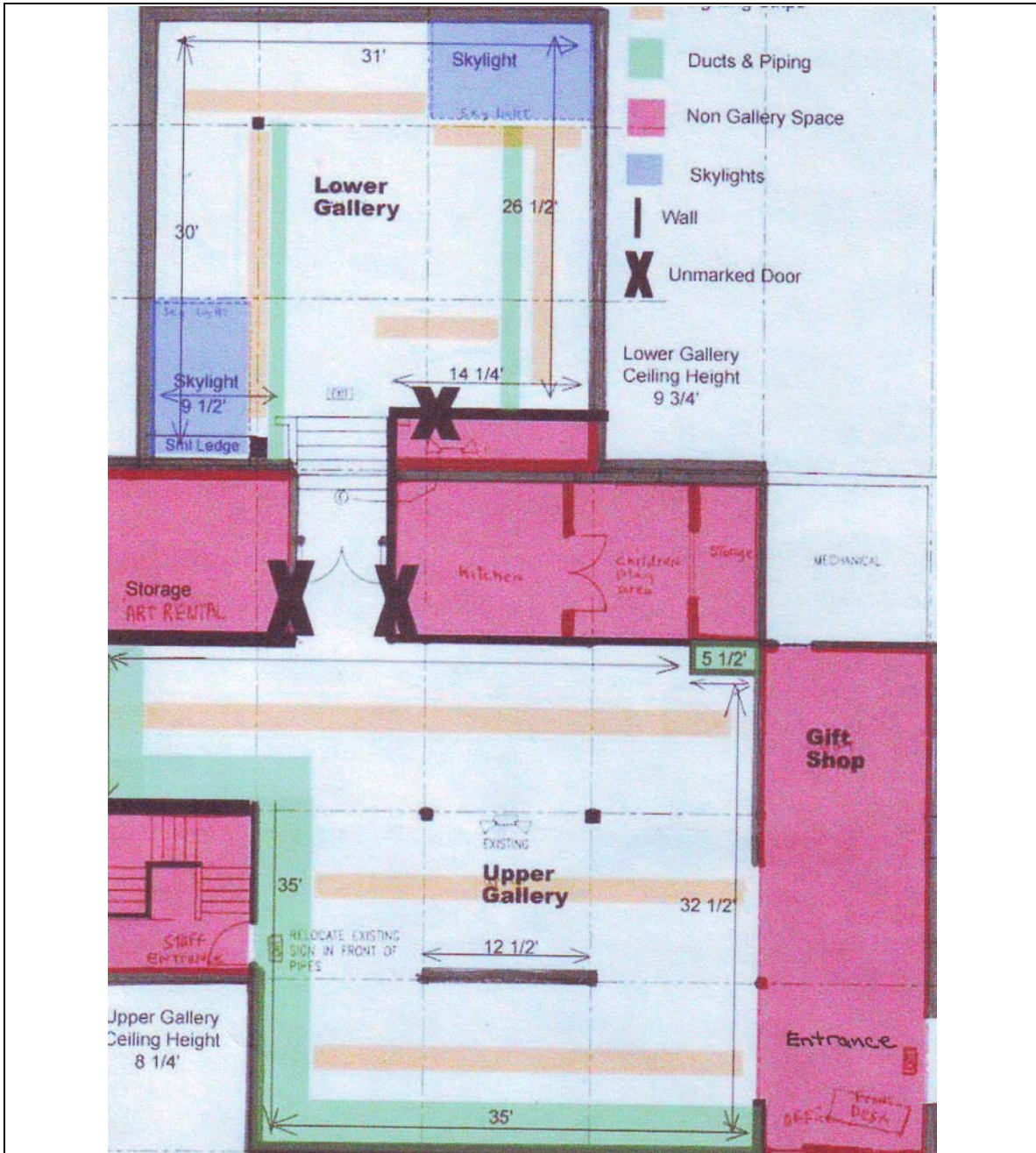
The Curatorial Committee will provide dated acknowledgement of proposals received.
